

How it works

Timed ticketing allows you to organize tickets into conditional categories, designated by specific times of entry. This helps regulate the flow of patrons through any venue – reducing long lines and overcrowding – which improves customer experience while increasing the ability to track admissions.

The flexibility of creating events with timed ticketing allows promoters to sell groups of tickets with their own time slot availability, and even conditional tickets with unique time slots that are unlocked after a primary ticket is selected. This is great for exhibits within an event.

Timed ticketing is popular among organizations that operate venues with multiple shows or exhibits per day; optimizing their box office's ability to sell tickets.

Conditional Scheduling

Prevents ticket purchases to events that overlap in duration.

Sold-out Time Slots

Time slots are visibly made unavailable if sold out, preventing accidental over-selling.

Check-in Manager

Staff may view a guest list for each time slot; streamlining the admission process.

Event Schedule Templates

Set up event schedules in advance by creating templates for recurring events. Duplicate when needed or set an autorepeat option.

Patron Tracking

Account for general admission and timed entry on a single ticket; helping improve management and tracking of a patron throughout the venue.

POS Kiosk

Supported on our portable ticket kiosk; alleviating box office congestion by offering a simple, self-service option for patrons.
